Organiser does not accept any responsibility for the undelivered, uncompleted or misscarried applications even if they were sent by registered mail.

Should the owner forget to indicate the class or should he/she do it incorrectly regarding the age, the organiser will enter the dog into a relevant class without notifying the owner. Application forms without copies of pedigrees will be send back. Documents received after the second entry close will be disregarded.

By signing and submitting the entry form, the exhibitor of the entered dog agrees to publication of his name and address in the show catalogue and on the web page of CBDDT, if not introduced opposite in the Entry form.

VETERINARY REGULATIONS

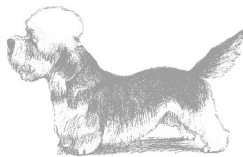
Dogs from abroad coming from EU member states and from thrid countries must have a valid EU PET PASSPORT with valid vaccinations and must fulfil the conditions laid down by the EU Regulation 998/2003 of 26. 5. 2003.

- All participating dogs must be clinically healthy.
- The dogs presented must have been vaccinated agains Rabies a minimum of 30 days prior to the show. The antirabic vaccination shall be valid for 12 months from the date of vaccination.
- The dogs of CZ origin must have a passport for small animals (EU pet passport) or a vaccination passport (according § 6 of veterinary law) containing a record showing, that the dog was vaccinated against rabies 21 days to 1 year before the show, and is in immunity against rabies and canine distemper, parvovirus and leptospirosis.
- Dogs that have not undergone the veterinary check-in control, must not participate at the show.

COMPLAINTS

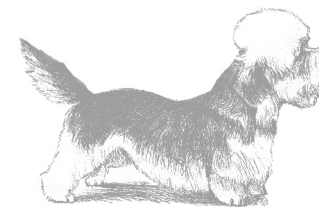
A complaint against any decision (as to evaluation, dog placement and entitlement) made by the judge shall not be permissible.

Formal complaints concerning violation of show rules and provisions may be filled. Such complaint must be submitted in writing and accompany a deposit of CZK 400 as surety during the duration of the shhow. If the complaint is found to be unjustified, this surety will be handed over to the organizer of the show.

CHALLENGE CERTIFICATES FOR THE TITLES AWARDED

Primus minor, CAJC, Club Junior Winner, CAC, res.CAC, CC a Club Winner, Best Veteran, BOB.
Titles Club Junior Winner and Cub Winner can be awarded just to the dog whose owner is participant of the KCHDDT.

COMPETITIONS

Child and a Dog, Best Brace, BestTeam.

All presented dogs in the competitions must have been presented in this show in which they must at least have achieved a single assesment "good" or have been exhibited in honorary class or veteran class.

CLASSES

Division into classes according to ČMKU guidelines (listed on the application). Registration for the class is only possible if the dog has reached the age limit required for the respective class a day before the day of the show date, the other show conditions must be completed before the date of the application. For each dog a separate entry form should be filled out. A dog can be entered only into one class. The four best dogs of either the baby or the puppy class shall be placed without class winner awarded. The dogs entered for Champion class shall only be registered as such, if the title "International or National Champion, National Winner, Club Winner or Special Terrier show Winner has been achieved by the day of the official entries close. **These titles must be confirmed for adult classes. A copy of the confirmation must be enclosed with the entry form. If the certificate is missing the dog will be entered in the "Open Class".** At this special show was opened the Not for competition class. These dogs who will be presented there shall not receive neither any form marks, nor they will be placed. This class was opened by this Club Breed show as suitable for the individuals, who have already gained the titles and whose owners want present their dogs not to inhibit the other dogs entered to get the titles.

Please, enclose a photocopy of the both sides of dog's pedigree – this applies to all applicants – and a copy of championship when registering dogs in a champion class or honorary class! The application will not be accepted without a both sides photocopy of the pedigree and without an evidence of the payment! Dogs exhibited can be entered only into one class.

There is included an entry payment for one person in an entry fee for the dogs entered. Bank transfer from abroad to the account name of KCHDDT: **157962830/0300, ČSOB, Praha 1.** Bank and post charges are to be paid by exhibitors. Attach the copy of a payment slip to the back side of the application form.

Payment order or a confirmation voucher of the bank will be considered as the unpaid! The application will not be accepted without an evidence of payment. The exhibitor commits to pay the exhibition fees even when he/she will not take part at the show. Should the show will not be held for the unforeseen cases the exhibition fees will be used to cover the expenses. The organiser may not accept the application without stating the reason.

When entering more than one dog, the baby, puppy, veteran or not for competition class dog cannot be considered to be the first dog.

For distinguishing of the payments for the first or the second deadline, the postal stamp date on the envelope containing the entry form is decisive.

Payment on the day itself till 9.00 o'clock + €10.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

The organiser or the Show Committee cannot be held responsible for damages caused by/to a dog or for the dog's illness, death or a loss. Owner is responsible for any damages caused by the dog or by the exhibitor.

The dogs that are not published in catalogue are excluded off the show as well as the dogs that bite, are ill, suspected of being ill, are infested with vermin or deformed dogs are permitted into the exhibition arena. Bitches in heat, highly pregnant bitches, breastfeeding bitches and individuals who have undergone surgery or cosmetically alter not be admitted. The dogs their owners was the forbidden the exhibition law will be excluded from judgement. A judge is obliged to disqualify aggressive dogs. Provoking dogs against each other is not allowed. Acceptance of the application will be confirmed in writing until ca 10 days before the show by an entry confirmation
